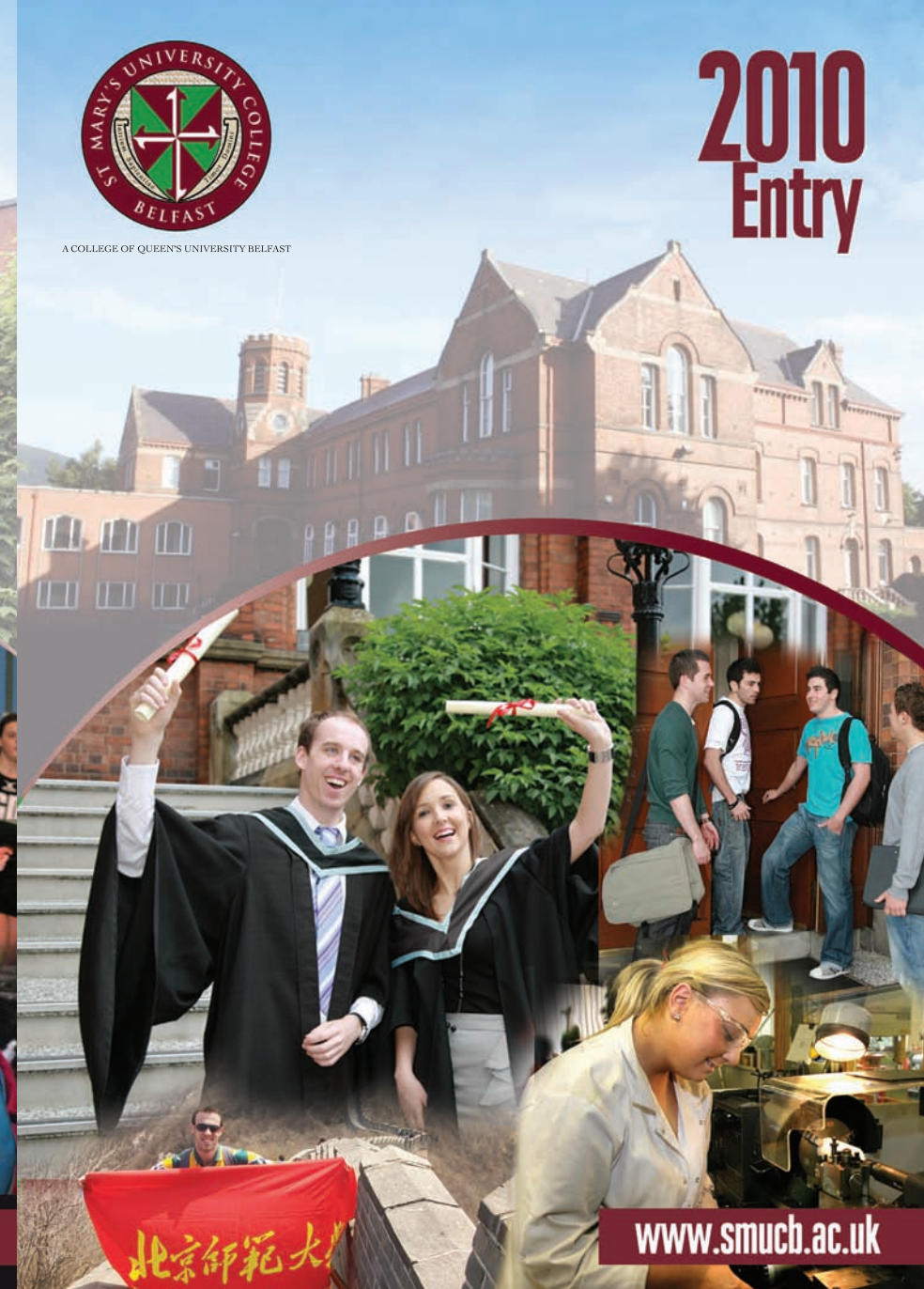
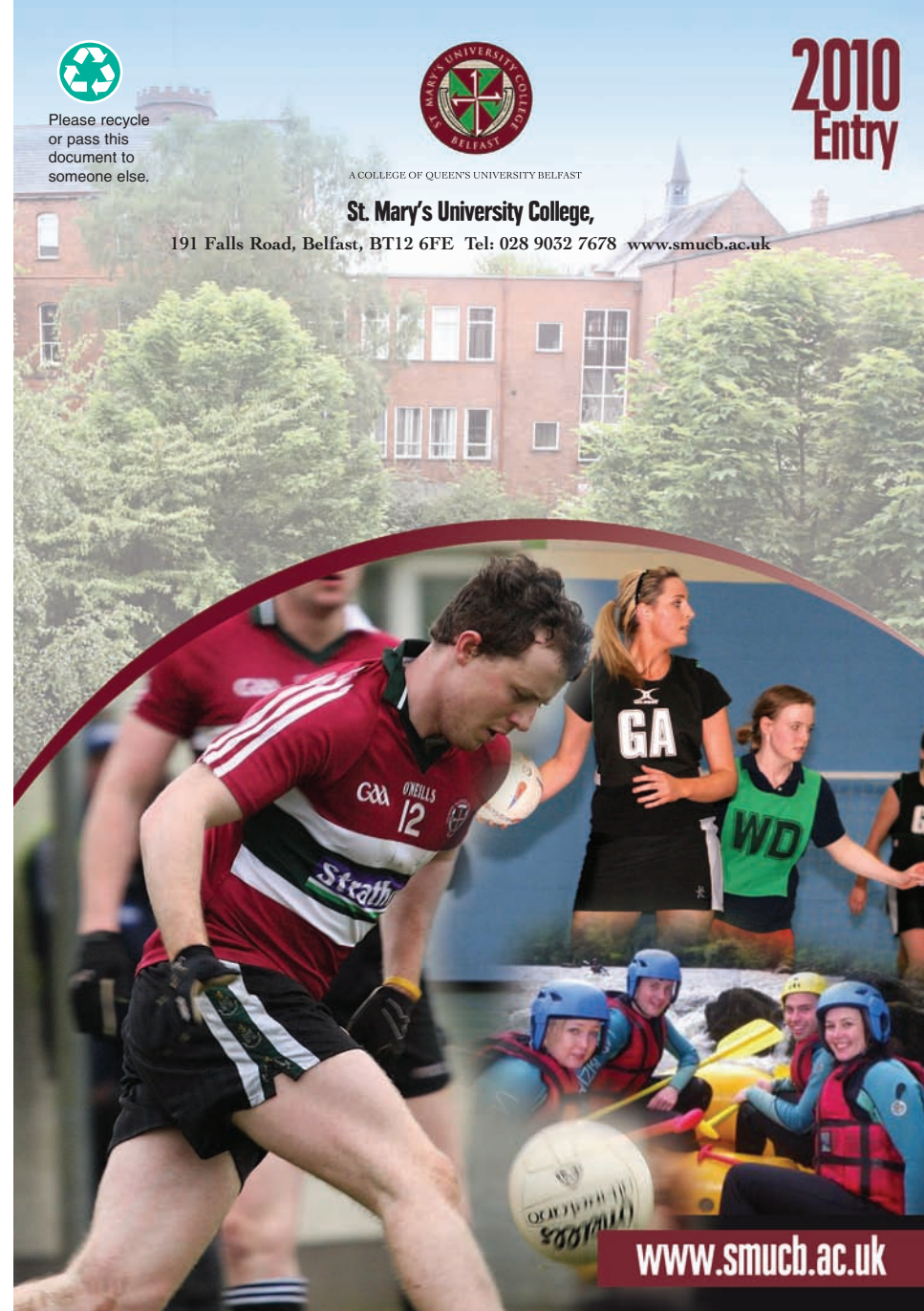

Additional information for BEd (Hons) applicants.

- All applicants for Primary courses of Initial Teacher Education must have GCSE grade C (or equivalent) in English, Mathematics and a Science subject (applicants born before 1st September 1981 **are no longer** exempt from the Science requirement).
- All applicants for Secondary courses of Initial Teacher Education must have GCSE grade C (or equivalent) in English and Mathematics.
- All applicants for Music should have a grade 6 standard (or equivalent) in instrumental or vocal study.
- Applicants to PE and Music may be required to undertake a practical assessment.
- The GCE 'A' level/ VCE subjects listed are required as part of the selection process. Advice on examinations deemed to be equivalent may be obtained by contacting the Admissions Office. Applicants should do this prior to submitting an application.
- For applicants applying from the Republic of Ireland, Leaving Certificate English and Mathematics grade D (Ordinary) are minimum requirements for both Primary and Secondary courses of Initial Teacher Education. In addition, applicants for Primary courses of Initial Teacher Education must have achieved Junior Certificate Science grade C (higher level).
- Applicants from the Republic of Ireland must have or be undertaking 6 Irish Leaving Cert. subjects at Higher Level in order to be considered for the BEd Primary or Secondary courses.
